

Official Proceedings of the Stutsman County Commission

January 2, 2007

At 4:00 p.m. the regular monthly meeting of the Stutsman County Commission was called to order by Vice-Chairman Klose. Roll call was answered by Douglas Kaiser, Craig Neys, Dennis Ova, Dale Marks, and Mark Klose.

A motion to approve the minutes of the December, 2006 meetings was made by Kaiser and seconded by Neys. Motion carried.

The Commission proceeded to reorganize for 2007. Noel Johnson, COO, asked for nominations for Chairman. A motion was made by Kaiser and seconded by Ova to nominate Mark Klose for Chairman. Neys made a motion that was seconded by Kaiser to cast a unanimous ballot for Mark Klose for Chairman. Motion carried.

Mark Klose chaired the remainder of the meeting.

A motion was made by Kaiser and seconded by Marks to nominate Dennis Ova for Vice-Chairman. Neys made a motion that was seconded by Marks to cast a unanimous ballot for Dennis Ova for Vice-Chairman. Motion carried.

Mike Zimmerman, County Road Superintendent, asked for permission to advertise for bids for a new motor grader. The purchase was in his 2007 budget. He recommended going to a 7 year replacement program instead of the current policy of replacing motor graders every 5 years. Kaiser made a motion that was seconded by Marks to advertise for bids for a new motor grader. Motion carried.

Mr. Zimmerman indicated that the shop foreman, Hartley Hoyt, was retiring so he asked for permission to advertise for a replacement. A motion was made by Ova and seconded by Kaiser to advertise for a shop foreman and to retain all full time positions which may require advertising for another position if any are vacated to fill the foreman position. Motion carried.

Jerry Bergquist, Chairman of the Personnel Committee, reviewed the history of the County's pay plan and the employee classification system. A revised classification system was approved in 2002. All employees had job descriptions and they were placed on a grade and step pay system that was competitive with the local job market. The pay plan consultant recommended a plan review every five years. The personnel committee reviewed Correction Officer wages. The Committee was recommending a grade increase for all correction officers.

Tracey Trapp, LEC Administrator, presented a list of Correction Officers that had resigned in 2006. Ten officers had resigned. There were a total of 22 positions so the turnover was almost 50%. Exit interviews indicated that wages and benefits were the most common reason for leaving. When advertising for CO I positions, he did not advertise the starting wage. It was over a \$1.00 per hour below what the starting wage for the same position at the James River Correctional Center in Jamestown. He presented a list of all Correction Officers and their wage if a grade increase was given. The total cost of approximately \$29,000 was included in the 2007 LEC budget. He also recommended a policy that would allow CO I positions to move up to a CO III position after 4 years of employment and after successfully completing testing for the position. This policy and better wages would help to retain trained employees. Kaiser made a motion that was seconded by Neys to give all Correction Officers a one-grade raise and to place the employees on the pay scale per the employee manual policy. This raise would be effective immediately. Roll call vote - Ova, Marks, Kaiser, Neys and Klose all voted aye.

A motion was made by Ova and seconded by Kaiser to contact the County's wage consultant for an estimate on the cost for a comprehensive review of the County's pay plan. Motion carried.

Neys made a motion that was seconded by Ova to appoint Bob Martin to the Stutsman County Weed Board. Motion carried.

Marks made a motion that was seconded by Ova to authorize the following 2007 automatic transfers and bills that could be paid on demand. Roll call vote - Marks, Kaiser, Neys, Klose and Ova all voted aye.

2007 Automatic Transfers:

Annual:

Budgeted health insurance amounts to the Hospital Insurance Fund;

Data Processing:

A budgeted transfer of \$119,000 as needed from the County Social Security Fund (Automation Levy) to the Data Processing Fund;

Monthly:

Transfer \$18,300 from the General Fund and 9-1-1 Fund to the County Correction Fund for dispatchers;

As Needed:

Transfer revenues from the Emergency Human Service Fund to the Regional Child Support Fund;

Transfer revenues from the Victim/Witness Assessment Fund to the Victim Witness Advocate Fund;

Transfer revenues from the Health Insurance Levy Fund to the Hospital Insurance Fund.

2007 Bills to be Paid on Demand:

Utilities - water, sewer, garbage, electricity and gas

Postage

State's Attorneys' filing fees with the North Dakota Supreme Court.

A motion was made by Neys and seconded by Kaiser to appoint Dennis Nelson to a four-year term on the Regional Airport Authority Board. Motion carried.

Kaiser made a motion that was seconded by Marks to pay the monthly bills. Roll call vote - Kaiser, Neys, Klose, Ova and Marks all voted aye.

Ova made a motion that was seconded by Marks to allow Sherri Kremeier to continue to work full time in the Recorder's Office through the end of February. Roll call vote - Neys, Klose, Ova, Marks and Kaiser all voted aye.

Commission Kaiser reported that Nick Grosulak had verbally agreed to an offer of \$11,000 to purchase their shop and mobile home at Pelican Point Landing. A purchase agreement would be drafted for the Park Board's approval at their February meeting.

Commissioner Klose reviewed a letter from Senator Conrad. Conrad's staff had met with a group concerned about the condition and safety of Stutsman County Roads 38, 37 and South 62. He was forwarding the materials sent to him to the Commission and indicated that as a U.S. Senator, he did not make decisions regarding the maintenance of county roads.

A motion to adjourn was made by Kaiser and seconded by Neys. At 4:55 p.m. the January 2, 2007 Stutsman County Commission meeting was adjourned.
