

Official Proceedings of the Stutsman County Commission

January 8, 2008

At 4:00 p.m. the regular monthly meeting of the Stutsman County Commission was called to order by Chairman Klose. Roll call was answered by Douglas Kaiser, Craig Neys, Dennis Ova, Dale Marks, and Mark T. Klose.

A motion to approve the minutes of the December meetings was made by Kaiser and seconded by Marks. Motion carried.

The Commission reorganized for 2008. Noel Johnson, County COO, requested nominations for Chairman. Ova made a motion that was seconded by Kaiser to nominate Mark Klose for Commission Chairman. Marks made a motion that was seconded by Neys to cast a unanimous ballot for Klose. Motion carried.

Klose chaired the remainder of the meeting.

Neys made a motion that was seconded by Kaiser to nominate Dennis Ova for Vice-Chairman. Marks made a motion that was seconded by Kaiser to cast a unanimous ballot for Dennis Ova. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Ova and seconded by Neys to appoint the following to five year terms on the Stutsman County Water Resource Board: John Schock and Jeff Mitchell (replacing Dennis Clark). Motion carried.

Kaiser made a motion that was seconded by Ova to approve the raffle permit application of the Ypsilanti Betterment Club. Motion carried.

The mid-month Commission meeting would be held at 8 a.m., January 22, 2008.

A motion was made by Neys and seconded by Kaiser to approve the beer license applications of the Jamestown Country Club and the Jamestown Speedway. Motion carried.

Ova made a motion that was seconded by Marks to approve the following 2008 transfers and bills to be paid upon demand. Motion carried.

2008 Automatic Transfers

ANNUAL: Budgeted health insurance amounts to the Hospital Insurance Fund;

A motion was made by Kaiser and seconded by Neys to advertise for electrical parts and labor and to advertise for plumbing and heating parts and labor. Motion carried.

Reese Hawkins spoke in favor of naming the Jamestown Reservoir Louis L'Amour Lake. He indicated that the Federal Government had never named the Reservoir - it had always been referred to as Jamestown Dam. He reviewed the author's donations to the community and his many accomplishments and various national awards. He requested that the Commission join the City Council, JSDC and Buffalo City Tourism and pass the resolution of support.

David Smette presented a letter of support for the name change. Steve Gasal commented that it was a tradition to name local land marks after famous people, and the arguments against the name change were in his opinion, petty.

Nathan Selchert, President of the Dakota Anglers, spoke in opposition to the name change. They had presented 896 signatures against the name change and now had an additional 1,504 signatures opposing the change. The organization did not see any benefit or improvement from a name change. Roy Werner requested the Commission to leave the name as it is.

Neys made a motion that was seconded by Kaiser to deny the request for approval of a resolution supporting the name change.

Dr. Robert Badal, Board Chairman - Jamestown Chamber of Commerce, presented an alternate resolution that would provide a neutral position on the name change proposal. He commented that the reasons for and against the proposal were difficult for the Commission and a neutral position would be preferred rather than creating a rift in the community.

When questioned by Selchert, Badal indicated that the proposal would still be presented to Senator Dorgan if the Commission took a neutral position on the name change. Ken Cumber stated that it was unfortunate that the Commission was put in the position of being for or against the name change proposal. Badal stated that Senator Dorgan had indicated that the issue had to come before the Commission, and that he himself would have liked to have avoided it. Dennis Lorenz mentioned that if the Commission was put in the position to vote one way or the other, a vote against the proposal would likely make it more difficult for Dorgan's office to push the bill through.

Commissioner Marks asked if the Chamber had conducted a community survey and if so, what was the outcome? Badal stated that a survey had not been done and that it was a misunderstanding that the Chamber had planned on doing a survey.

Commissioner Ova declared a conflict of interest and requested permission to vote. Kaiser made a motion that was seconded by Marks to allow Ova to vote on the motion. Motion carried.

Roll call vote on the motion - Ova - aye, Marks - nay, Kaiser - aye, Neys - aye and Klose - aye. Motion carried.

Commissioner Marks presented the proposed long range road plan. The five year improvement plan specified work ranging from total reconstruction to recycling roads. The \$18.65 million cost would be paid over a period of ten years provided voters approved a 1% County wide sales tax and a 30 mill property tax increase on agricultural property.

Noel Johnson, County COO, reviewed the road proposal's funding plan. The 1% sales tax would generate \$1.8 million annually. These funds would provide debt service on a \$14.42 million bond. The 30 mills would provide \$570,000 annually. The 30 mills would increase property taxes an average of \$0.42 per acre.

Gayne Gasal questioned the plan's proposal of recycling old Highway #10 from the Bloom interchange to Spiritwood. It was the most traveled road in the County. The traffic would increase with the Spiritwood Energy Park and people would not travel the extra miles to take Interstate I-94 as an alternate route.

Comments were heard from the public in attendance in regard to property tax dollars, sales tax dollars, resurfacing, recycling, road usage, and general comments.

The Commission would continue to work on the road plan, request community input, and wait for the State's Attorney's opinion on whether or not the County could levy 30 mills on agricultural property, only.

Neys made a motion that was seconded by Kaiser to authorize the following fund transfers. Transfer from Fund 10 - \$248,250 to Fund 15 - \$2,000, to Fund 19 - \$11,000, to Fund 21 - \$4,000, to Fund 23 - \$180,000, to Fund 27 - \$4,500, to Fund 33 - \$4,000, to Fund 40 - \$26,500, to Fund 73 - \$7,500, and to Fund 91 - \$8,750; from Fund 11 to Fund 53 - \$119,000; from Fund 13 to Fund 10 - \$1,379.53; from Fund 14 to Fund 23 - \$96,300; from Fund 15 to Fund 54 - \$7,500; from Fund 19 to Fund 69 - \$36,200; from Fund 32 to Fund 15 - \$1,200,000; from Fund 40 to Fund 10 - \$4,325; from Fund 43 to Fund 39 - \$15,000; from Fund 46 to Fund 30 - \$270,000; from Fund 49 to Fund 24 - \$30,812; from Fund 58 - \$360,952.97 to Fund 17 - \$225,952.97 and to Fund 18 - \$135,000. Roll call vote – Marks, Kaiser, Neys, Klose and Ova voted aye.

A motion was made by Ova and seconded by Neys to pay the 2007 accounts payable and to pay the 2008 January bills. Roll call vote – Kaiser, Neys, Klose, Ova and Marks voted aye.
