

Official Proceedings of the Stutsman County Commission

February 16, 2010

At 8:00 a.m., Chairman Klose called the regular meeting of the Stutsman County Commission to order. Dale Marks, Doug Kaiser, Craig Neys, and Mark T. Klose answered roll call. Dennis Ova was absent.

Neys made a motion seconded by Kaiser to transfer the Hitching Post liquor license from Lucas Gudmestad to Shawn Dell Gudmestad-Moore. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Marks seconded by Kaiser to approve \$255.00 in taxable meals. Roll call vote – Marks, Kaiser, Neys and Klose voted aye.

Noel Johnson, County COO, reviewed the certification of agricultural values for 2010. The State Tax Department certified a 13.6% increase in Stutsman County's agricultural land values. The County would have to raise values at least 8% to be within the State's tolerance standards. The legislative formula used 10 years of historical crop and livestock production. The increase in 2010 was a result of recent higher gross cropland income and a lower capitalization rate. The capitalization rate was lowered for 2010 and 2011 by the 2009 legislature.

The motor grader bids were opened as follows: Butler Machinery Company, Fargo, ND - \$264,597 less trade of \$95,274 for a net price of \$169,323 with an optional extended warranty of \$23,200, Guarantee buyback of \$115,000 for motor grader only; Guarantee buyback of \$115,000 for motor grader with wing; and \$115,000 for motor grader and all snow equipment. Net total cost \$77,523. Swanston Equipment Corporation, Fargo, ND - \$285,817 less trade of \$95,274 for a net price of \$190,543 with an optional extended warranty of \$13,000, Guarantee buyback of \$132,953 for motor grader only; Guarantee buyback of \$138,391 for motor grader with wing; and \$145,217 for motor grader with all snow equipment. Net total cost \$58,326. RDO Equipment Company, Bismarck, ND - \$239,000 less trade of \$95,274 for a net price of \$143,726 with an optional extended warranty of \$25,500, Guarantee buyback of \$111,000 for motor grader only; Guarantee buyback of \$115,500 for motor grader with wing; and \$117,500 for motor grader and all snow equipment. Net total cost \$51,726. The bids were tabled for review until the next meeting.

Jerry Bergquist presented the resolution for renewing the 9-1-1 fees. The \$1.00 per month fee was on "assessed communications services" pursuant to NDCC 57-40.6. The funding was essential to support the operation and maintenance of the 9-1-1 emergency services communications system. Kaiser made a motion seconded by Marks to approve the resolution that would place the issue on the June 8, 2010 primary election ballot. Motion carried.

Reed Schwartzkopf, Jamestown City Engineer, requested the County's assistance for 2010 flood preparedness. The request was being made to the County and State with the expectation that neither had the resources to assist. The request and denial was necessary in order to acquire federal assistance. Neys made a motion seconded by Kaiser to deny assistance to the City. Roll call vote – Kaiser, Neys, Klose and Marks vote aye.

Jill Warburton requested the Commission consider saving Old Highway 10 from recycling.

Dave Orr received no vehicle bids. He would solicit bids for the next meeting.

A motion was made by Marks seconded by Neys to pay the mid-month bills. Roll call vote – Neys, Klose, Marks and Kaiser voted aye.
