

Official Proceedings of the Stutsman County Commission

March 4, 2008

At 4:00 p.m. the regular monthly meeting of the Stutsman County Commission was called to order by Chairman Klose. Roll call was answered by Douglas Kaiser, Craig Neys, Dennis Ova, Dale Marks, and Mark T. Klose.

A motion to approve the minutes of the February meetings was made by Neys and seconded by Kaiser. Motion carried.

Zenithe Mayer, Jamestown Sun/Prairie Post Advertising, asked the Commission to consider placing an ad in the Progress Addition. Ova made a motion that was seconded by Marks to purchase the ½ page ad. Motion carried.

Neys made a motion that was seconded by Kaiser to approve the Spiritwood Betterment Club's application for a bingo permit. Motion carried.

Noel Johnson, County COO, requested the approval of a Joint Powers Agreement (JPA) between Stutsman County and the North Dakota Association of Counties. The JPA would enable the purchase of e-poll book computers with several other counties for the upcoming elections at a reduced price. The e-poll books would be a lease/purchase over a three-year period. The 2008 lease payment would be approximately \$1,234 per e-poll book. A motion was made by Kaiser and seconded by Ova to enter into the JPA with the NDACo. Roll call vote – Ova, Marks, Kaiser, Neys and Klose voted aye.

A motion was made by Ova and seconded by Kaiser to advertise for bids for pasture leases (gravel pits) in Corwin and Hidden Townships. Motion carried.

Ova made a motion that was seconded by Neys to deny the abatement requests of Harley J. McLain on parcel #'s 35-2810000, 35-02820000, 35-2830000, 35-2840000 and 35-5500010 for tax years 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005 and 2006 because Mr. McLain had failed to set out any legitimate reason for granting the request, Mr. McLain had no legitimate tax exemption, and/or Mr. McLain was tardy missing both the NDCC 57-23-04 deadline and the NDCC 57-20-20 deadline. Roll call vote – Marks, Kaiser, Neys, Klose and Ova voted aye.

Fritz Fremgen, States Attorney, gave his monthly report.

The Commission had the first reading of Stutsman County Ordinance #2008-1, Sales Tax and Land Tax for Roads. Jeremy Wilson questioned the legality of passing a resolution that would tax agricultural property at a different rate than other classes of property. Fremgen responded that State Law does, and has taxed classes of property differently. Craig Headland indicated that he had legal questions regarding the increase on ag land only. He stated that the County's Home Rule Ordinance could not supercede state law and that the Commission only had those powers as delegated by the Legislature. He was in favor of increasing the taxes on all classes of property. Judy Graves aired concerns about having the right repair on the right road at the right time. She questioned the cost per mile to purchase rather than renting a recycle machine. She indicated that Cargill Malt, Great River Energy, and the Newman Group should be asked for matching funds to repair the roads leading into the Energy Park. Terry Wanzek indicated that he was willing to pay his fair share. The County roads were a benefit to the entire community including the ag based economy in Jamestown. The Commission concurred to continue the publication process pending the Attorney General's Opinion.

Tracy Trapp, LEC Administrator, requested allowing County employees to donate sick leave and annual leave to a Law Enforcement Center employee. A motion was made by Ova and seconded by Neys to allow the donated leave. Motion carried.

Sandy Bendewald, representing the County Personnel Committee, requested approval of a plan that would convert State Merit Grades to County pay grades. Kaiser made a motion that was seconded by Marks to place Merit System grades 3, 4, 7, 13 and 15 to County pay grades 2, 3, 6, 16 and 20 respectively. Roll call vote – Kaiser, Neys, Klose, Ova and Marks voted aye.

Warren Tobin, Veterans Service Officer, reported on the Fiscal Year (FY) 2007 statistics for VA medical benefits received by Stutsman County Veterans. 598 veterans received medical care in FY 2007 for a total cost of \$2.8 million in VA provided care and Non-VA care provided through local clinics. To reduce appointment backlogs, non-VA care through local clinics doubled in 2007.

Harold Newman requested that the Commission reconsider its vote on renaming the Reservoir to Lake Louis L'Amour. He indicated that the lake was not named at all. Chairman Klose asked for a motion to place renaming the lake on the next Commission agenda. No motion was made.

At 5:37 p.m. the Commission meeting was recessed for the Park Board meeting.

#### Stutsman County Park Board Meeting

March 4, 2008

At 5:38 p.m. the Stutsman County Park Board meeting was called to order by Chairman Klose. Roll call was answered by Dennis Ova, Dale Marks, Doug Kaiser, Craig Neys and Mark Klose. Mark Schlecht and Bob Woodward were absent.

Ova made a motion that was seconded by Neys to approve the minutes of the February 5, 2008 meeting.

A motion was made by Neys and seconded by Kaiser to pay the monthly bills. Roll call vote – Ova, Marks, Kaiser, Neys and Klose voted aye.

Sandy Eckelberg, County Accounts and Property Coordinator, reviewed the grants that were being sought for Park Board projects. The grant had been turned down last year for a new concession building at Pelican Point Landing. The grant would be resubmitted using the cost of building only. Stutsman County Rural Water had applied for a grant that would assist with the cost to install rural water at Pelican Point. The shower/bathrooms at Lakeside Campground and Pelican Point Landing were not ADA compliant. The facilities need to be compliant by 2010. Reclamation has \$218k for Title XVIII work. Remaining ADA funds would be used for vault toilets on the Island at the Reservoir. Options for bringing rural water into Lakeside campground would be pursued. Estimated cost is \$27-\$30k. The ND Game and Fish Department would pay for an accessible fishing pier at Parkhurst. ADA accessibility costs were around \$30,000. Funds could be sought from the Game & Fish Department, the Dakota Anglers and from a Garrison Diversion Grant. The Game and Fish Department had approved a 32' dock at Spiritwood Lake; a 44' dock would continue to be requested.

Dennis Lorenz, County Park Superintendent, reported that there was some electrical work that needed to be completed for the Phase II upgrade to the Pelican Point campgrounds. The government surplus backhoe from the Bureau would be picked up.

A motion to adjourn the Park Board meeting was made by Neys and seconded by Ova. At 6:00 p.m. the March 4, 2008 Park Board meeting was adjourned.

At 6:01 p.m. the Stutsman County Commission meeting was called back to order with all members present.

Ova made a motion that was seconded by Neys to pay the monthly bills. Roll call vote – Neys, Klose, Ova, Marks and Kaiser voted aye.
