Official Proceedings of the Stutsman County Commission – March 21, 2017

At 4:30 p.m., Chairman Klose called the regular meeting of the Stutsman County Commission to order. Dale Marks, David Schwartz, Denny Ova, Mark T. Klose, and Craig Neys answered the roll call.

Ashley Tanata, Accounts and Property Coordinator, presented the board with an application for a Special Permit for a wedding dance in August. Ova made a motion to approve the special permit, seconded by Neys. Motion carried.

Corry Shevlin, Jamestown Stutsman Development Corporation (JSDC), presented the board with an Amendment for the Magnum LTL Flex Pace that had an 80/20 City/County split. A motion was made by Schwartz, seconded by Marks to accept the amendment as a presented. Roll call vote: Neys, Klose, Ova, Marks, Schwartz, voted aye. Motion carried.

Shevlin presented the board with a University of Jamestown (UJ) Entrepreneurship Center Request where the JSDC Board of Directors recommended granting the UJ Entrepreneur Center up to \$50,000 a year for three (3) years on an 80/20 City/County split. Marks made a motion to accept the UJ Entrepreneurship Center request as presented, seconded by Ova. Roll call vote: Klose, Ova, Marks, Schwartz, Neys voted aye. Motion carried.

Shevlin presented the board with an Unmanned Aerial System (UAS) Incentive Program. The JSDC Board of Directors unanimously approved this program to move forward seeking approval from Stutsman County. A motion was made by Schwartz to approve this program as presented, seconded by Ova. Roll call vote: Ova, Marks, Schwartz, Neys, Klose voted aye. Motion carried.

Chad Kaiser, Sheriff, introduced Sheriff Dean Danzeisen of Mercer County. Sheriff Danzeisen is here to pick up the investigation that was started by the Village regarding a harassment claim that State's Attorney Fremgen said was filed with him. Sheriff Danzeisn expects to wrap up his investigation shortly and will report his findings to Sheriff Kaiser.

Casey Bradley, Auditor/COO, provided the board with an amendment do the DOT budget bill currently being proposed in the legislature. This Amendment not only shifts financial responsibility, but other liability onto the county. Schwartz made a motion to oppose the amendment, seconded by Marks. Roll call vote: Marks, Schwartz, Neys, Klose, Ova all voted aye. Motion carried.

Neys made a motion, seconded by Ova to approve the mid-month bills and taxable meals. Roll call vote: Schwartz, Neys, Klose, Ova, Marks, voted aye. Motion carried.
