

Official Proceedings of the Stutsman County Commission – April 16, 2019

At 4:45 p.m., Chairman Mark Klose called the regular meeting of the Stutsman County Commission to order. Denny Ova, Dave Schwartz, Steven Cichos and Mark Klose answered the roll call. Ramone Gumke was absent.

Jamison Veil, Jamestown City Assessor, requested an abatement for parcel number 74-1973500. The City of Jamestown approved the request at an April 1, 2019 meeting. Schwartz made a motion, seconded by Ova, to approve the requested abatement as presented. Roll call vote: Schwartz, Cichos, Klose and Ova voted aye. Motion carried.

A review and award for a motor grader was presented by Mickey Nenow, Road Superintendent. This motor grader will go to Cleveland. Ova made a motion to approve the lowest bid from RDO Equipment, seconded by Schwartz. Roll call vote: Cichos, Klose, Ova and Schwartz voted aye. Motion carried.

Schwartz has been contacted by the Kensal Fire Department with interest in the old Kensal road maintenance building. They would be responsible for all costs associated with the building. A 20-year lease was discussed. Schwartz made a motion, seconded by Cichos, to draw up a lease upon approval of both entities. Motion carried.

Tammy Ibach from North Dakotans for Comprehensive Energy Solutions and her policy advisor presented an update on wind energy in North Dakota.

Nicole Meland, Auditor/COO, stated Stutsman County hasn't received 6 Memorandum's of Agreement from townships for FEMA money. These townships include Ashland, Gerber, Griffin, Kensal, Paris and St. Paul.

Meland reminded the commissioners of a County appreciation cook-out on Tuesday, April 23, 2019 at 4:30 p.m. put on by Bank Forward.

Schwartz made a motion to approve the taxable meals and mid-month bills, seconded by Ova. Roll call vote: Klose, Ova, Schwartz and Cichos voted aye. Motion carried.
