

Official Proceedings of the Stutsman County Commission

May 17, 2011

At 8:00 a.m., Chairman Klose called the mid month meeting of the Stutsman County Commission to order. Dennis Ova, Dale Marks, David Schwartz, Craig Neys and Mark T. Klose answered roll call.

Commissioner Neys questioned why Mr. Johnson was at the meeting since he had announced his retirement at the April 19, 2011 commission meeting. Neys thought that his retirement was effective May 1 and that he had taken offense to Johnson's outburst at the April meeting. Marks stated that it was a process that they needed to go through and that it had been a tough time with all the changes going on. Mr. Johnson left the meeting. Klose, Ova and Schwartz stated that no specific date for retirement was given other than as-soon-as-possible. Marks stated that the county had land evaluations to do, road problem issues and office changes that needed to be done and that Johnson played an important part in finishing these items. Marks also stated that Johnson needed to vent and that happened to be the time. Neys stated he had taken offense to the outburst and that he had not asked him to leave the meeting.

At 8:06 a.m., Klose and Ova left the meeting to visit with Johnson.

At 8:08 a.m., Klose and Ova returned to the meeting.

Jason Bitz, Insure Forward, presented the 2011 insurance renewal for business auto, inland marine and general liability. The conferment for 2011 was \$27,259, an increase from 2010 of \$1,779. The premium for business auto and general liability decreased while the premium for inland marine had increased. The 2011 premium was \$68,576, down \$5,222 from 2010. Neys made a motion seconded by Schwartz to renew the insurance for 2011. Roll call vote – Ova, Marks, Schwartz, Neys and Klose voted aye.

Brian Dooley, Rose Township Supervisor, requested a loan from the County for an emergency grade raise. He indicated that the project should receive FEMA funding and that the County would be paid as soon as the township received reimbursement. The township was levying the maximum of 36 mills. Mickey Nenow, County Highway Superintendent, said that FEMA would pay for emergency grade raises. Ova made a motion seconded by Schwartz to approve a \$10,000 loan for three (3) years at 5% interest from the interim fund. Roll call vote – Marks, Schwartz, Neys, Klose and Ova voted aye.

Nenow reported that the ER bid opening was at 9:00a.m. Klose said to table the award until they knew which funds the dollars were coming from. A special meeting would be held on May 18, 2011 at 7:00 a.m. to review the bids and funding.

Nenow also stated that the Bloom Road needed to be restriped before the striping completely wears away to avoid the cost of resurveying. Commission gave approval for restriping the Bloom Road.

Steve Thompson, Interstate Engineering, presented the engineering estimate of \$820,000 for the Gavilon Grain Road. Fritz Fremgen, State's Attorney, reviewed and gave approval of the bidder's bond from the one bid that had been received. The bid from Border States Paving, Inc was opened and the base bid was \$784,570.16. Thompson would review the bid tabs and the bid could be reviewed at the special meeting already set for May 18, 2011.

Fremgen stated that the County really needed to have a contract in place with Gavilon Grain for payment of this project. The letter of support from Gavilon was given to Fremgen to have a contract ready for the special meeting. The bid award was tabled until the May 18th special meeting.

The salary for the Interim Treasurer was reviewed. Schwartz made a motion to raise the Interim Treasurer to a grade 13 step 1. This was consistent with what the previous treasurer had received. Marks seconded the motion. Roll call vote – Schwartz, Neys, Klose, Ova and Marks voted aye.

Commissioner Schwartz made a motion that the Interim Recorder be paid a flat \$800 per month for her additional duties and to pay retirement on the earnings. Ova seconded the motion. Roll call vote – Neys, Klose, Ova, Marks and Schwartz voted aye.

A motion was made by Neys and seconded by Schwartz to approve payment of \$132.50 in taxable meals. Roll call vote – Klose, Ova, Marks, Schwartz and Neys voted aye.

Schwartz made a motion seconded by Ova to approve payment of the mid-month bills. Roll call vote – Ova, Marks, Schwartz, Neys and Klose voted aye.
