Official Proceedings of the Stutsman County Commission – May 19th, 2015

At 8:00 a.m., Chairman Klose called the mid-month meeting of the Stutsman County Commission to order. Mark T. Klose, Dennis Ova, Dale Marks, David Schwartz, and Craig Neys answered the roll call. Dale Marks is absent.

Jason Bitz, Insure Forward, presented the commission with the renewal of insurance of General Liability, In-Land Marine and Auto Coverage. The premium in 2014 was \$100,553 with a refund of \$14,276 for a total cost of \$86,277; in 2015 the premium is \$97,958 with a refund of \$12,608 for a total cost of \$85,350. Neys made a motion, seconded by Ova to renew coverage with Insure Forward. Motion carried.

Connie Ova, JSDC, requested approval of a change from the original allocation of 30-40 acres to up to 80 acres to be allocated for a crew camp for temporary workforce housing in the JSDC Spiritwood Property at the rate of \$600 per acre. The crew camp looks like it may be a little larger than was anticipated. Ova made a motion, seconded by Schwartz to approve increasing the acreage as presented. Motion carried.

Connie Ova updated the commissioners regarding the changes to the JSDC policies. The policies were last updated in 2009. The policies were updated to make it easier to read, to make it more concise, and to ensure they comply with North Dakota Century Code. Ova made a motion, seconded by Schwartz to approve the revised JSDC policies. Roll call vote: Ova, Schwartz, Neys, Klose voted aye.

Tyler Perleberg, Interim Tax Director, is requesting to hire an additional staff appraiser. The assessor training bill passed in the legislature which essentially created two classes of assessors. Class one is equivalent to your Director of Tax Equalization and city assessors who have a population of over 5,000 people. Class two is equivalent to your city and township assessors who have a population under 5,000 people. Class one requirements didn't change much. Class two was previously required to participate in a 24 hour course, pass a test plus take a four hour refresher course every year to continue their education; the new requirements now are 80 hours of training with ten hours of continuing education. Perleberg spoke with the current assessors to see how many of the assessors would continue to be assessors; 15 of the 16 assessors stated they would not continue assessing. Stutsman County currently does the assessing for 23 townships and eight small cities. The county could potentially take on 30 more townships and one small city. The additional position is in the current budget. Schwartz made a motion, seconded by Ova to approve hiring a second staff appraiser. Motion carried.

Mickey Nenow, County Highway Superintendent, requested approval to renew the license on their current software program. The original price was \$1320 per year for a 12 month period. Josh Smaage, IT Director, negotiated with the software company to renew the software program for three years for \$2400. Neys made a motion, seconded by Schwartz to approve renewing the software as presented. Motion carried.

Neys made a motion, seconded by Ova to approve the taxable meals and mid-month bills. Roll call vote: Schwartz, Neys, Klose, Ova voted aye.
