At 8:00 a.m. the mid-month meeting of the Stutsman County Commission was called to order by Chairman Klose. Roll call was answered by Douglas Kaiser, Craig Neys, Dennis Ova, Dale Marks, and Mark T. Klose.

Steve Steinborn and Nancy Fuchs, Insure Forward, presented the County's 2008 insurance renewal – Business Auto \$41,276.00; General Liability \$43,720.00; Inland Marine \$10,994.00; Hartford Steam \$5,370.30; Conferment \$38,429.00, for total proposal of \$62,931.30. This amount is a decrease of \$3,231.75 from the 2007 premium. Neys made a motion that was seconded by Kaiser to accept the proposal. Roll call vote – Ova, Marks, Kaiser, Neys and Klose voted aye.

Sandy Bendewald, Social Services Administrator, requested permission to offer a 57% Social Worker II salary and a 43% Social Worker III salary as recommended by the Social Service Board to fill a vacant position. Ova made a motion that was seconded by Marks to approve the salary. Roll call vote – Marks, Kaiser, Neys, Klose and Ova voted aye.

Jerry Bergquist, 9-1-1 Coordinator/Emergency Manager, requested consideration of another burning ban. All but one of the County fire chiefs had requested the ban. The ban would be in effect from 8:30 a.m. May 20 to 5:00 p.m. June 3. The ban could be rescinded earlier if the area receives measurable rain. A motion was made by Kaiser and seconded by Marks to impose the burning ban. Roll call vote – Kaiser, Neys, Klose, Ova and Marks voted aye.

Mike Zimmerman, County Highway Superintendent, and Steve Thompson, Interstate Engineering, reported on Federal ER (Emergency Relief) Funds remaining for paving the Cleveland and Gackle grade raises along County Highway 67. The funds would be available provided the projects were ready for the November, 2009 bid letting. The funds would pay for 80% of the projects including engineering. Kaiser made a motion that was seconded by Marks to proceed with the paving projects as a projected cost of \$352,860 and to pay for the County's share of the cost from the emergency fund. Roll call vote – Neys, Klose, Ova, Marks and Kaiser voted aye.

Thompson reported that the paving contractor would begin work on the Ypsilanti Road by mid-June. Zimmerman indicated that road restrictions would be removed on May 27th. He reported that they had been having trouble with one of the Case motor graders. Titan Machinery would replace the machine.

Neys made a motion that was seconded by Ova to appoint Dennis Clark as an alternate to the Stutsman County Water Resource Board. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Marks and seconded by Ova to pay \$377.50 in taxable meals. Roll call vote – Klose, Ova, Marks, Kaiser and Neys voted aye.

Kaiser made a motion that was seconded by Neys to pay the mid-month bills. Roll call vote – Ova, Marks, Kaiser, Neys and Klose voted aye.
