

Official Proceedings of the Stutsman County Commission

June 3, 2008

At 4:03 p.m. the regular monthly meeting of the Stutsman County Commission was called to order by Chairman Klose. Roll call was answered by Douglas Kaiser, Craig Neys, Dennis Ova, Dale Marks, and Mark T. Klose.

A motion to approve the minutes of the May, 2008 meetings was made by Marks and seconded by Kaiser. Motion carried.

Connie Ova, JSDC-CEO, presented a request by Champ Industries USA, Inc. for additional funding for their 2008 expansion. \$2,355 in addition PACE interest buy downs funds and \$15,365 in additional New Jobs training funds were requested on an 80/20 City/County split. Kaiser made a motion that was seconded by Neys to approve the \$3,544 in additional County funds. Roll call vote – Ova, Marks, Kaiser, Neys and Klose voted aye.

Noel Johnson, County Zoning Administrator, reviewed the Conditional Use Permit application of Todd Timm for a livestock feedlot expansion up to 999 animal units in the W1/2 of Section 36-T144N-R64W, Kensal Township. Adjacent property owners had been notified and all zoning requirements had been met. At their May 22, 2008 meeting, the Stutsman County Zoning Board recommended approval of the application. Marks made a motion that was seconded by Kaiser to approve the Conditional Use Permit. Roll call vote – Marks, Kaiser, Neys, Klose and Ova voted aye.

A motion was made by Kaiser and seconded by Marks to nominate Dr. Philip Jystad to the Central Valley Health District Board, Katherine Meidinger to the Stutsman County Library Board, Ruth Urdahl and Beverly Brunsch to the School Reorganization Committee and Charles Purdy to the Jamestown City Planning Commission. Motion carried.

Steve Thompson, Interstate Engineering, indicated that the paving contract for the ER (Emergency Relief) Highway 67 grade raises would be forthcoming. The Cleveland grade raise was nearing completion. The Ypsilanti road paving should be completed by July 4th. The Gackle grade raise had a completion date of July 18th – the contractor had not begun the work.

Mike Zimmerman, County Highway Superintendent, reported that he and the State's Attorney were preparing a letter to begin the process to abate the encroachment of right of ways on County roads. Adjacent owners of the land had been informed of the requirement to discontinue cropping the right of ways.

Zimmerman indicated that a legislator would be willing to sponsor a bill that would be similar to current Minnesota law. The legislative change would allow law enforcement to audit weigh tickets at local grains elevators. Any violation of local weight restrictions on County roads would be subject to prosecution. Commissioner Marks voiced his concern that without the hauler's consent, the practice would be an invasion of privacy.

Zimmerman reported that the ND Department of Transportation had up to \$250,000 in SRF (Special Road Funds) grant funds that could be used on the County's AHL roads for chip sealing. The grant requires \$100,000 in matching funds. Kaiser made a motion that was seconded by Marks to proceed with acquiring the funds. Motion carried.

Zimmerman indicated that it would be necessary to add another fuel premium to the rates charged to townships and cities for road maintenance and gravel hauling. Current diesel fuel prices were over \$4.60 per gallon.

Fritz Fremgen, State's Attorney, reviewed the issues with the encroachment along county roads. The right of way would have to be ascertained. Adjacent land owners would be contacted to request their cooperation. The letter would outline the issues with the requirement that the right of way would have to be reseeded to grass with the proper grass mixture. The letter would impose a deadline of June 15, 2009 for compliance.

Neys made a motion that was seconded by Ova to approve the following liquor licenses, Sunday alcoholic beverage permits and off premises permit subject to the completion of all the necessary paper work. Liquor Licenses: Jamestown Country Club, Stutsman County Fair Association, Inc, Joey Uehran d/b/a 281 Stop, Lucas Gudmestad d/b/a Hitching Post Bar, Krewzer's Dream, Inc. (Krissi & Robert Wenzel) d/b/a Buchanan Bar; Sunday Alcoholic Beverage Permit: Jamestown Country Club, Joey Uehran d/b/a 281 Stop, Wayne & Hilda Kuntz d/b/a Sportsman Bar, Sandra Norquist d/b/a Ypsilanti Bar & Grill; Off Premises Permit: Carmel Demaray d/b/a Windsor Bar. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Marks and seconded by Kaiser to appoint Dennis Ova - Commission Representative; Noel Johnson – County Auditor; Karen Samek – County Recorder; Delores Rath, Dean Remboldt, Ruth Urdahl and Tom Christensen – District 12 and District 29 Party Representatives to the 2008 primary election canvass board. Motion carried.

Ova made a motion that was seconded by Neys to approve the raffle permit application of Jamestown United Way at the Ypsilanti Bar and Grill. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Neys and seconded by Ova to approve the gaming site authorization for Knights of Columbus at the Windsor Bar, Sportsman Bar, Hitching Post Bar and Ypsilanti Bar & Grill. Motion carried.

Jerry Bergquist, 9-1-1 Coordinator/Emergency Manager, requested acceptance of a \$12,000 grant to allow “Nick of Time” to re-write the County’s Hazardous Materials Response Plan. The \$3,000 matching funds would be paid in-kind. Ova made a motion that was seconded by Marks to accept the grant funds.

Kaiser made a motion that was seconded by Marks to add Lance Brower, Wayne Fyelling, Sue Lunde, Robyn Phillips and Andrew Schneider and to delete Jennifer Eckman, Thomas Olson and Steve Reidburn as members of the LEPC (Local Emergency Planning Committee). Motion carried.

A motion was made by Ova and seconded by Kaiser to accept the \$38,194 in ND Department of Emergency Services (DES) operating grant funds that were used to pay salaries in Bergquist’s Emergency Management Office. Motion carried.

At 5:04 p.m. the Commission meeting was recessed for the County Park Board meeting.

Tara Kapp, Membership and Communications Coordinator with the Jamestown Chamber of Commerce, requested approval of the special event permit for “Jam the Dam” that would be held August 15, 16 and 17, 2008 at the Jamestown Reservoir. Ova made a motion that was seconded by Neys to approve the special event permit. Motion carried.

Dennis Lorenz, County Park Superintendent, gave his monthly report. 300 trees had been planted at the Reservoir’s nursery. The damage to the sign and split-rail fence by a motorist had been repaired. Phase II at Pelican Point Landing was complete. Johnson informed Lorenz of complaints about the narrow parking spots on some of the camping pads. Clay would be hauled to widen some of the pads. The four cabins at the Marina Campgrounds were all hooked up and ready to go.

A tree dedication ceremony would be held at the Marina to honor Bill Moffet for his contributions with assisting the disabled. The Bureau of Reclamation would present one of their highest honors to the Moffet family in connection with the annual C.A.S.T (Catch a Special Thrill) event that would be held June 26th.

The ND Game and Fish had indicated they would install a toilet facility on the north side of Spiritwood Lake where the former fish hatchery was located provided the Park Board would maintain the facility. Kaiser made a motion that was seconded by Schlecht to enter into the maintenance agreement. Motion carried.

A motion to adjourn the Park Board meeting was made by Schlecht and seconded by Neys. At 5:26 p.m. the June 3, 2008 County Park Board meeting was adjourned.

At 5:27 p.m. the Stutsman County Commission meeting was called back to order with all members present.

Neys made a motion that was seconded by Marks to pay the monthly bills. Roll call vote – Kaiser, Neys, Klose, Ova and Marks voted aye.
