

Official Proceedings of the Stutsman County Commission

June 5, 2007

At 4:00 p.m. the regular monthly meeting of the Stutsman County Commission was called to order by Chairman Klose. Roll call was answered by Douglas Kaiser, Craig Neys, Dennis Ova, Dale Marks, and Mark T. Klose. Also present were Bill Chapin, and Bill and Nellie Degen.

A motion to approve the minutes of the May meetings was made by Neys and seconded by Kaiser. Motion carried.

Connie Ova, CEO JSDC, presented a request to amend their 2007 budget by \$9,723.30 to allow payment of property taxes. JSDC had contested these taxes as they feel they are a tax exempt entity similar to other government agencies. JSDC has requested the ND Attorney General's office to review their tax status and plans on paying the taxes pending the AG's ruling. Kaiser made a motion that was seconded by Marks to amend the JSDC operating budget. Roll call vote - Ova, Marks, Kaiser, Neys and Klose all voted aye.

Mike Zimmerman, County Highway Superintendent, gave his monthly report. Crews were busy patching, Highway 38 milling was in progress, and County Highway 67 north of Gackle by the Hehn/Schafer Lake was under water. Townships were contacted to report water damage to roads. Not all had responded, but the area between Gackle and Cleveland seemed to be the hardest hit. Jerry Bergquist, 911/Emergency manager, reported that in this area, there were long detours to get around inundated roads. Zimmerman presented options to raise Highway 67. Bergquist recommended an emergency declaration that would initiate the County's Emergency Plan and free up emergency funds. Ova made a motion that was seconded by Kaiser to declare an emergency and order the activation and utilization of the Combined Emergency Operations Plan for Stutsman County. Roll call vote - Marks, Kaiser, Neys, Klose and Ova all voted aye.

One of the three cost estimates presented by Zimmerman exceeded \$50,000. Fritz Fremgen, State's Attorney, issued an opinion that the County would have to bid the repairs if the cost exceeded \$50,000. Kaiser made a motion that was seconded by Marks to hire Guthmiller to raise County Highway 67 at a cost not to exceed \$50,000. Roll call vote - Kaiser, Neys, Klose, Ova and Marks all voted aye.

Ova made a motion that was seconded by Neys to authorize the County Highway Superintendent to prepare specifications to bid the remaining repair project for the grade raise on County Highway 67. Roll call vote - Neys, Klose, Ova, Marks and Kaiser all voted aye.

Fritz Fremgen, State's Attorney, gave his monthly report. The Bureau of Reclamation had withdrawn its offer to allow a lottery to lease Lot 1, East Side, Jamestown Reservoir.

A motion was made by Ova and seconded by Kaiser to approve the following liquor licenses and Sunday alcoholic beverage permits for July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008, and the beer license (expiration December 31, 2007) and special off-premise event permit. Roll call vote - Klose, Ova, Marks, Kaiser and Neys all voted aye.

A motion was made by Kaiser and seconded by Ova to approve the gaming site authorization request of the Knights of Columbus at Ypsilanti Bar & Grill. Motion carried.

At 5:09 p.m. the Commission meeting was recessed for the Park Board meeting.

A motion was made by Woodward and seconded by Schlecht to approve the minutes of the May meeting. Motion carried.

Woodward made a motion that was seconded by Neys to approve the bills. Roll call vote -Woodward, Schlecht, Ova, Marks, Kaiser, Neys, and Klose, all voted aye.

Noel Johnson, County COO, reported that there were concerns by the neighbors of Lot 1, East Side, Jamestown Reservoir about grass and weed maintenance now that the site was vacant. Larry Kuntz, Bureau of Reclamation, indicated that a decision from the Bureau about the disposition of the lot would be made in the near future. Until then, Dennis Lorenz, County Park Superintendent, indicated that his crew would take care of the lot.

Johnson requested the Board decide on a reversion date for the cabin owners to decide on seasonal versus year-around cabin leases. While a central collection system alternative was being explored, cabin owners had an opportunity to revert back to a seasonal permit and receive a pro-rata share of the cost difference between seasonal versus year around permits. Now that the septic system issue had been resolved, Johnson requested a deadline date for reversion requests. A motion was made by Marks and seconded by Schlecht to establish October 1, 2007 as the deadline for reversion requests and to send a notification letter to the cabin owners. Motion carried.

Jack Uehran, Spiritwood Lake Campground Sublessee, presented a proposal to give up his lease on the campgrounds at Spiritwood Lake City provided the Board purchases his house for \$75,000. The campground lease transfer would include all permanent structures, water, sewer and electrical facilities. The Board could bid for a concessionaire and run it similar to the Marina and Pelican Point Landing. Kaiser, Schlecht, Fremgen, Johnson and Lorenz would review the proposal and report back to the Board.

The Board had received a request by Spiritwood Lake City for the Board's support on a decision by the City to have the travel trailers that are located on the Lake frontage on the County's property that is leased to Jack Uehran moved as they are not in compliance with City zoning. Board member Mark Schlecht consented to attend a City Council meeting to help resolve the issue.

Dennis Lorenz, County Park Superintendent, gave his monthly report. He presented pictures of vandalism damage at the Parkhurst Campground. The shelter's fireplace was destroyed. The damage had been reported to the Sheriff's Department and reported to the County's insurance provider. The shelter had a history of vandalism. He would seal up the fireplace with concrete. The Dakota Anglers were happy with the repair padding on the docks and they would assist with funding similar repairs to all the other docks. The annual CAST (Catch a Special Thrill) event would be held on June 26th. The fishing event for disabled individuals was sponsored and staffed by the Bureau of Reclamation and the County Park Department. The Board was invited to attend.

Neys made a motion that was seconded by Schlecht to authorize Lorenz to offer not more than \$75

each for the three window air conditioners that had been purchased by Nick Grosulak and left at Pelican Point Landing. Roll call vote - Marks, Kaiser, Neys, Klose, Schlecht, Woodward and Ova all voted aye.

The next Park Board meeting would be held July 10th instead of July 3rd.

A motion to adjourn was made by Neys and seconded by Schlecht. At 5:50 p.m. the June 5, 2007 Park Board meeting was adjourned.

At 5:51 p.m. the Stutsman County Commission meeting was called back to order with all Commissioners present.

Ney's made a motion that was seconded by Ova to pay the monthly bills. Roll call vote - Ova, Marks, Kaiser, Neys and Klose voted aye.
