

Official Proceedings of the Stutsman County Commission

June 19, 2007

At 8:00 a.m. the Stutsman County Commission meeting was called to order by Chairman Klose. Roll call was answered by Douglas Kaiser, Craig Neys, Dennis Ova, Dale Marks, and Mark T. Klose.

Robin Izsler, Central Valley Health District Administrator, presented the annual report for the Central Valley Health District. Also present was Marcia Bollingberg, Director of Nursing for the Health District. The Health District's annual budget was \$1.5 million. Funding resources were 47% Federal, 28% local, 3% state, and 22% fees and donations. 25 staff members provided services for 25,000 nursing, 5,000 WIC, 1,300 family planning, 631 Title III, and 235 Woman's Way client contacts. The agency also provided environmental health and emergency preparedness services.

Eunice Sahr representing the County's Wellness Committee requested consideration of a plan that would allow employee's to receive comp time as a reward for completing strenuous physical activities, for making healthy lifestyle choices and for following healthy nutritional choices. The employees would complete a daily chart that would monitor these activities. The daily log would be submitted monthly and reward points would be accumulated. A maximum of 8 hours comp time could be accumulated in a 12-month period. The hours could not be banked and no compensation would be paid out for any employees that left the county's employment. Participation would be voluntary. The proposal was tabled for further consideration.

Mike Zimmerman, County Highway Superintendent; Jerry Bergquist, 911 Coordinator/Emergency Manager; and Steve Thompson, Interstate Engineering; updated the Commission on current road conditions. Several roads were under water. County Highway 67 south of Cleveland was under water in two spots. Application would be made for Emergency Relief (ER) funding. Cost estimates for grade raises ranged from \$370,000 to \$630,000. Engineering expenses to date were about \$32,000. A Presidential disaster declaration was necessary so local governments could access federal relief funds. It would take about 45 days to complete the necessary steps before road repairs could be made. Neys made a motion that was seconded by Marks to submit a report on the status of the County roads with cost estimates for repair to the ND Department of Transportation and if ER funds become available to engage Interstate Engineering for their services to prepare plans and specifications for repair of the damaged roads. Roll call vote - Ova, Marks, Kaiser, Neys and Klose all voted aye.

Mr. Zimmerman requested allowing overtime for his department to get the necessary work completed. They were behind in road maintenance and repairs. A motion was made by Kaiser and seconded by Ova to allow overtime for road department employees. Motion carried.

Mr. Zimmerman reported on a complaint by a resident that was concerned about the noise from truckers using their "jake brake" when they descended the hill west of the livestock yard. The Commission considered this a safety issue so they would not post signs prohibiting use of the jake brakes.

Ova made a motion that was seconded by Kaiser to appoint Kelly Krein to the Stutsman County Housing Authority. Roll call vote - Marks, Kaiser, Neys, Klose and Ova all voted aye.

Kaiser made a motion that was seconded by Marks to appoint Vicki Struxness and LaRae Jorgenson to the Stutsman County Library Board. Roll call vote - Kaiser, Neys, Klose, Ova and Marks all voted aye.

A motion was made by Ova and seconded by Kaiser to appoint Cindy Schaar (to fill the unexpired term of Leo Ryan) to the Central Valley Health Authority Board. Roll call vote - Neys, Klose, Ova, Marks and Kaiser all voted aye.

Marks made a motion that was seconded by Ova to nominate Laurie Carlson for the School Reorganization Committee. Motion carried.

Kaiser made a motion that was seconded by Neys to nominate Alice Pekarski for the School Reorganization Committee. Motion carried.

Johnson reported that Eric Godel, County's Computer Support Specialist, had resigned to take a position with the State Attorney General's Office. The position was being advertised.

Kaiser made a motion that was seconded by Marks to pay \$87.50 in taxable meals. Roll call vote - Klose, Ova, Marks, Kaiser and Neys all voted aye.

Ova made a motion that was seconded by Kaiser to pay the mid-month bills including \$218.00 to Mike Zimmerman from 15-128-6340. Roll call vote - Ova, Marks, Kaiser, Neys and Klose all voted aye.
