

Official Proceedings of the Stutsman County Commission – June 19th, 2012

At 8:00 a.m., Chairman Klose called the regular meeting of the Stutsman County Commission to order. Denny Ova, Dale Marks, David Schwartz, Craig Neys, and Mark T. Klose answered the roll call.

The purchase prices were almost identical with the trade in without figuring in the fuel consumption and the buyback option. The motor grader operator preferred to drive the John Deere over the cat. Schwartz recommended accepting RDO Equipment's bid for the motor grader. Schwartz made a motion, seconded by Marks to accept the bid from RDO Equipment. Roll call vote: Ova, Marks, Schwartz, Neys, Klose voted aye.

Reed Schwartzkopf, City of Jamestown Engineer, is requesting funding for the James River Feasibility Study in the amount of \$8,000 to \$12,000 for Phase I. Phase I is a one-time request. Marks made a motion, seconded by Neys to approve \$2,000 for 2012 and \$10,000 for 2013 contingent upon other counties participation for Phase I of the James River Feasibility Project. Roll call vote: Marks, Schwartz, Neys, Klose, Ova voted aye.

DeAnn Brunner and Gary Riffe, Jamestown Stutsman Development Corporation are requesting a Pace Interest Buy Down for Pam & Jerry Szarkowski of RTS Shearing. The funding request is for up to \$135,000 for a PACE Interest Buy down to construct a new building to be occupied by RTS Shearing. The recommendation includes legal documentation for long term lease of the property which extends up to two years past the date that the building is paid off, personal guarantees from Pam and Jerry Szarkowski and best possible security position on the building. The project is to be funded on an 80/20 with the County's share being \$27,000. The loan would be repaid upon completion of the project. Neys made a motion, seconded by Schwartz to approve the request as presented. Roll call vote: Schwartz, Neys, Klose, Ova, Marks voted aye.

DeAnn Brunner and Gary Riffe are requesting additional funding for the E-Nugget/Carbontec Energy Corporation. The request is for an additional cash investment match funding of 80/20 with the County's share being \$16,000. This match is to provide the deficit from the APUC Grant. Ova made a motion, seconded by Marks to approve the request as presented. Roll call vote: Neys, Klose, Ova, Marks, Schwartz voted aye.

Todd Volk, Assistant 9-1-1 Coordinator/Emergency Manager, presented the status of the current and proposed Mutual Aid Agreements. Currently, the mutual aid agreements are with nine contiguous counties touching Stutsman County, Cass County, and Burleigh County. The mutual aid agreements are in place if there are any FEMA requirements with reimbursements with a disaster declaration. Last August, all counties signed except for Logan County and Burleigh County. The request is to resend the mutual aid agreement to Burleigh County and Logan County; and enter into a new mutual aid agreement with the City of Jamestown, Richland County, City of Fargo and the City of Bismarck. Ova made a motion, seconded by Schwartz to approve the request. Motion Carried.

Todd requested permission to contract for CodeRED services with Richland County. This is an automatic emergency notification system. Richland County uses this program and they like it. The program has the capability to send text messages, emails, or makes phone calls. This system has the ability to send a message to everyone in the county or to specific areas. Everyone who has a landline will be

automatically enrolled in CodeRED. Those who have a cell phone or email address can sign up. It would be free of charge. Stutsman County will contract directly through Richland County. This will save the county approximately \$2,500 each year. The transitional contract will be from July 1, 2012 through February 22, 2013. It will cost the county \$8,594.85. Starting February 22, 2013 will be the start of a three year contract with Richland County. The CodeRED system will cost \$13,048.00 each year. Ova made a motion, seconded by Marks to approve the request as presented. Roll call vote: Klose, Ova, Marks, Schwartz, Neys voted aye.

Todd requested permission for out of state travel for Christi Jarland to attend the APCO International Conference in Minneapolis, MN. Schwartz made a motion, seconded by Neys to approve the out of state travel request. Motion Carried.

Todd requested permission for out of state travel for Jerry Bergquist, Dorinda Brown, and himself to travel to Brown County, SD to tour the Brown County Communications Center. Ova made a motion, seconded by Marks to approve the out of state travel request. Motion Carried.

Todd updated the commissioners on the long-distance outage last week Thursday. A fiber optic line was accidentally cut. It affected Century Link and Daktel phone lines. Our 9-1-1 system was not working properly due to the cut fiber optic line. Our 9-1-1 calls are long distance calls; the calls are routed to Fargo and then back to Stutsman County for the eastern side of the state. The 9-1-1 phone calls were immediately re-routed to state radio in Bismarck that came through the cell phone. Stutsman County sent out media alerts and television scrolls to the public. Century Link reported the cables were fixed around 6:45 p.m.

Todd presented a bid process for purchasing 9-1-1 equipment. Stutsman County will let Richland County take the lead in the bid process. Richland County will solicit and open bids publicly at their meeting. Stutsman and Richland County will review the bids and make a recommendation to each of their commission boards. Schwartz made a motion, seconded by Ova to approve the bid process for purchasing 9-1-1 equipment. Motion Carried.

Due to Title VI requirements, Stutsman County needed to publish and advertise the open board appointments. The prospective appointee would need to fill out an application. Neys made a motion, seconded by Ova to approve the appointment of Cynthia Schaar to the Central Valley Health Committee. Motion Carried. Schwartz made a motion, seconded by Ova to approve the appointment of Kelly Krein to the Housing Authority Committee. Motion Carried. Ova made a motion, seconded by Schwartz to approve the appointments of Brian Amundson, Harold Bensch, Duane Andersen, and Ryan Odenbach to the Zoning Board Committee. Motion Carried. Neys made a motion, seconded by Ova to approve the appointments of Charles Axtman, Terry Schwartz, and Dwight Hofmann to the School Reorganization Committee. Motion Carried.

Neys made a motion, seconded by Schwartz to approve a local raffle permit for the Anne Carlsen Center Foundation. Motion Carried.

Casey Bradley, Auditor/COO, presented information for the 2013 budget. Casey will be sending out budget worksheets to the department heads next week. In 2012, one mill generated \$66,743.00, for 2013 one mill will generate \$72,735.60. This is an increase of \$5,992.60. The health insurance is projected to increase by 16%. The General Aid from the state is projected to increase approximately \$300,000 to \$400,000. We will need to adopt the 2013 budget by the first week in October.

Mike Hanson, NDSU Extension, requested to fill the Agriculture Agent Extension position. Mike received a resignation letter from Lance Brower. Dale Marks, Dennis Ova, and Christina Rittenbach will be on the committee to represent Stutsman County. Ova made a motion, seconded by Schwartz to approve to partner with NDSU and hire an Ag Extension Agent. Roll call vote: Ova, Marks, Schwartz, Neys, Klose voted aye.

Ova made a motion, seconded by Schwartz to approve a step increase from step 3 to step 6 for the Benefits/Account Coordinator. Roll call vote: Marks, Schwartz, Neys, Klose, Ova voted aye.

Schwartz made a motion, seconded by Ova to approve pending completion of paperwork for a Sunday Alcoholic Beverage Permit for Carmel Demaray dba Windsor Bar. Motion Carried.

Marks made a motion, seconded by Neys to approve the taxable meals and mid-month bills for payment. Roll call vote: Schwartz, Neys, Klose, Ova, Marks voted aye.
