Official Proceedings of the Stutsman County Commission

At 4:00 p.m., Chairman Klose called the regular meeting of the Stutsman County Commission to order. Dennis Ova, Dale Marks, Craig Neys, Doug Kaiser and Mark T. Klose answered roll call.

A motion to approve the June minutes was made by Kaiser, seconded by Marks. Motion carried.

A motion to appoint Dr. Edward Anderson to the Central Valley Health Board, Alice Pekarski to the School Reorganization Board and Carolyn Cichos to the Housing Authority Board was made by Ova, seconded by Neys. Motion carried.

Mike Zimmerman, County Highway Superintendent, reported 3 small ER projects have been completed and payment has been requested. A motion to pay for the 3 projects was made by Neys, seconded by Kaiser. Roll call vote – Ova, Marks, Kaiser, Neys, and Klose voted aye. Correspondence has been received regarding private contractors hauling gravel out of the county pits. Gravel has been hauled from county pits by private contractors; therefore, the county gravel supply in certain areas of the county has been depleted. Now when the county or township needs gravel in those area it has to be hauled further and is going to have higher transportation costs. A motion to adhere to county policy was made by Kaiser, seconded by Marks. Roll call vote – Ova, Marks, Kaiser, Neys, and Klose voted aye. Zimmerman withdrew his mileage reimbursement request.

Jerry Bergquist, 911 Coordinator/Emergency Manager reported that the Multi-Hazard Mitigation Planning Grant deadline has been extended to February 1, 2011. A motion was made by Ova to nominate the following persons for the Local Emergency Planning Committee; Spencer Johnson, Deanna VanBruggen, Lt. Mitcheal Brecto, John DeVary, Tom Lindberg, Brenton Nesemeier, and Todd Volk, seconded by Marks. Motion carried. Bergquist stated the county has received a Homeland Security Radio Reprogramming Grant in the amount of \$28,730 with a 10% match of 911 fees to pay for the reprogramming of all law enforcement, fire and ambulance radio frequencies. A motion to accept the Radio Reprogramming Grant was made by Neys, seconded by Kaiser. Roll call vote – Ova, Marks, Kaiser, Neys, and Klose voted aye.

At 4:46 p.m. the County Commission meeting was recessed for the County Park Board meeting.
