Official Proceedings of the Stutsman County Commission - August 1, 2017

At 4:00 p.m., Vice-Chairman Ova called the regular meeting of the Stutsman County Commission to order. David Schwartz, Denny Ova, Craig Neys and Dale Marks answered the roll call. Absent was Mark Klose.

Schwartz motioned to approve minutes for the last two meetings, seconded by Neys. Motion carried.

Corry Shevlin, JSDC, discussed pace funding for JK Holdings. The County share will be \$43,000. Marks motioned to approve funding for JK holdings, seconded by Schwartz. Ova, Marks, Schwartz, and Neys voted aye. Motion carried.

Mickey Nenow, County Highway Superintendent presented 5 quotes for new windows and doors for the office. He recommended accepting the second offer from Northland Windows and Doors, which was for \$8,166.00. Schwartz motioned to accept quote from Northland Windows and Doors, seconded by Marks. Marks, Schwartz, Neys, Ova voted aye. Motion carried.

Mickey Nenow requested a change in the work order for the County Road 63 project. The project was budgeted to work on three culverts by Spiritwood Lake. The project came under budget and they now have extra money he would like to use for a project to repair two culverts on Highway 10. He recommended accepting the quote from Subsurface for \$25,569.60 to fix the culverts. Neys made motion to fix the culverts on Highway 10, seconded by Schwartz. Schwartz, Neys, Ova, and Marks voted aye. Motion carried.

Kim Franklin, Assistant Emergency Manager, presented a consideration to ratify the Stutsman County Drought Emergency Declaration. The drought declaration signed by Klose was only good for 7 days until the County Commission could ratify the declaration. Since the governor signed an executive order for a drought disaster, the declaration would bring help for livestock producers and would free up the National Guard if large fires occur. Other neighboring counties have signed similar declarations. Schwartz motioned to ratify the Drought Emergency Declaration, seconded by Neys. Motion carried.

Shannon Larson, Human Resource Specialist, presented options for vision and dental benefits for county employees. These are voluntary employee carried benefits with no cost to the county. Larson, along with the Wage and Benefits committee, recommended offering these benefits to employees. Schwartz motioned to offer the dental and vision insurance, seconded by Marks. Neys, Ova, Marks, and Schwartz voted aye. Motion carried.

Jessica Alonge, Treasurer, requested approval to remove Shannon Larson from bank accounts. Motion made by Neys, seconded by Schwartz. Motion carried

Fritz Fremgen, State's Attorney presented his monthly report.

Nicole Meland, Deputy Auditor/Recorder presented new job descriptions for review. These were already reviewed and recommended for adoption by the Personnel Committee. The Audit Support Assistant and Accounts/Property Coordinator were both made Deputy Auditor at the same pay grade. An

accountability statement was also added to all job descriptions. Schwartz made a motion to accept all job description changes, seconded by Marks. Ova, Marks, Schwartz, and Neys voted aye. Motion carried.

Meland presented a new renewal agreement for 2018 with Jamestown Community Correction Program. The cost went up from \$1.25 to \$1.30 for each hour of community service. This was approved by the LEC board. Motion made by Schwartz to approve the agreement, seconded by Neys. Marks, Schwartz, Neys, Ova voted aye. Motion carried.

Meland announced that the meeting with Senator Hoeven's office on Wednesday, August 2nd has been cancelled.

Meland announced that a delegate for NDACo needs to be appointed. Neys made a motion to nominate David Schwartz as delegate, seconded by Marks. Motion carried

Meland presented changes to the Flex Bank Account for approval. Previous employees need to be removed from the account and new employees need to be added. Neys made a motion to approve the changes, seconded by Schwartz. Schwartz, Neys, Ova, and Marks voted aye. Motion carried.

Meland requested the committee approve Jessica Alonge to perform marriages as she will be the Interim Recorder. Ova made a motion to approve, seconded by Marks. Motion carried.

Meland requested to add Jessica Alonge to the Personnel Committee as she will be the Interim Deputy Auditor. Schwartz motioned, seconded by Marks. Motion carried.

At 4:31 p.m., the Stutsman County Commission Meeting recessed for the County Park Board Meeting.
