

Official Proceedings of the Stutsman County Commission

August 5, 2008

At 3:00 p.m. the special meeting of the Stutsman County Commission was called to order by Chairman Klose. Roll call was answered by Douglas Kaiser, Craig Neys, Dennis Ova, Dale Marks, and Mark T. Klose.

Warren Tobin, Veterans Service Officer, representing the Stutsman County Wage and Benefit Committee presented the committee's proposal for the 2009 budget. Also present were Jan Thompson, Joan Halvorson, Theresa Steele and Leslie Uecker. Tobin indicated that the 5.7% cost of living increase was the largest increase in over 20 years. The committee was requesting a 5% COLA, a step increase, the second half of the Archer pay adjustment and that the County pick up the cost of the projected 8% increase in health insurance premium cost.

Andrew Schneider, Jamestown Regional Airport Manager, and Board members Johnny Klingenberg, Jim Boyd, and Dennis Nelson requested an increase from one mill to two mills for the regional airport. The airport was projecting a \$43,000 deficit for 2009 due to increased fuel costs, runway repairs and aging facilities. The numbers were up at the airport – July, 2008 was the busiest month in 2 ½ years.

Noel Johnson, County COO, presented the materials and a preliminary review of the 2009 budget. No increases in employee wages were included in the preliminary numbers as submitted by the County Department heads. The preliminary numbers projected \$411,000 in deficit spending for 2009.

Mike Zimmerman, County Highway Superintendent, reviewed the road department budget. The \$100,000 purchase of assets would replace a front end loader with a smaller, more portable machine. Zimmerman gave his monthly report. The \$61,000 grant to replace the department's radios had been approved. The \$250,000 grant to chip seal the AHL roads had been approved. The \$380,000 cost would be added into the 2009 budget.

At 3:57 p.m. the special meeting of the Stutsman County Commission was adjourned.

At 4:02 p.m. the regular monthly meeting of the Stutsman County Commission was called to order by Chairman Klose with all members present.

A motion to approve the minutes of the July, 2008 meetings was made by Neys and seconded by Kaiser. Motion carried.

Connie Ova, JSDC-CEO, presented the contract between JSDC, the City of Jamestown and Stutsman County. Prior to this agreement, there had been no written contract between the respective entities – only an implied contract. A motion was made by Kaiser and seconded by Marks to approve the contract. Roll call vote – Ova, Marks, Kaiser, Neys and Klose voted aye.

Ms. Ova requested \$3,000 on an 80/20 City/County split to hire a Jamestown College student as an intern to assist with the Jamestown College Connections subcommittee. Neys made a motion that was seconded by Marks to approve the \$600 in County funds. Roll call vote – Marks, Kaiser, Neys, Klose and Ova voted aye.

Maynard Helgaas, Garrison Conservancy District Board Director, submitted his resignation as a Director of the Garrison Conservancy District effective October 15, 2008. He recommended former NDSU County Extension Agent, Tom Olson, as his replacement. A motion was made by Marks and seconded

by Neys to nominate Tom Olson to replace Mr. Helgaas. Motion carried. Chairman Klose thanked Mr. Helgaas for his years of service and his diligent efforts working to benefit the community.

Craig Headland, speaking as a concerned citizen and as a State Representative, requested the Commission ask the voters at the 2008 general election for a 6 mill increase in road funds so the County's total road levy would be at the statewide average. He indicated that it may be difficult for the Legislature to support more money for the County unless the County had exhibited an effort to help themselves by having a road mill levy at the statewide average. The Commission expressed concerns about support for more property taxes in light of the recent overwhelming rejection of the County's road plan by the voters at the primary election. The extra \$350,000 a year would do little considering the high oil prices and corresponding high costs for all aspects of the road department. Mr. Headland commented that assurances by the Commission that any mill levy increase would be offset by decreases in other spending may convince voters to support more road funds from property taxes.

Dennis Ova made a motion that was seconded by Kaiser to appoint Jan Thompson as the County's delegate to the North Dakota Association of Counties conference. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Kaiser and seconded by Ova to approve the application of Casey Dodgson d/b/a Buffalo Lanes, Inc. for a liquor license for the Stutsman County Fair Grounds and an off premises permit for a private event in Buchanan Township. Motion carried.

Ova made a motion that was seconded by Neys to approve the site authorization request of the ND Buffalo Foundation at the Jamestown Country Club. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Kaiser and seconded by Marks to award the digital aerial photography contract for mapping Jamestown City to Aero-Metric, Inc. Roll call vote – Kaiser, Neys, Klose, Ova and Marks voted aye.

Marks made a motion that was seconded by Ova to accept \$105,672.60 in Public Safety Interoperable Communications (PSIC) Equipment Grant funds for the Communications, Corrections, Emergency Management and Road Departments. Motion carried.

At 4:47 p.m. the Commission meeting was recessed for the County Park Board meeting.

At 4:52 p.m. the Stutsman County Park Board meeting was called to order by Chairman Klose. Roll call was answered by Dennis Ova, Dale Marks, Doug Kaiser, Craig Neys, Mark Klose, Mark Schlecht and Bob Woodward.

A motion was made by Woodward and seconded by Schlecht to approve the minutes of the July 1, 2008 meeting. Motion carried.

Ova made a motion that was seconded by Woodward to pay the monthly bills. Roll call vote – Schlecht, Woodward, Ova, Marks, Kaiser, Neys and Klose voted aye.

Rick McKay, cabin owner, requested an extension for septic system compliance due to health problems that have caused a financial hardship. The Board informed him that the deadline was October 31, 2008.

Sandy Eckelberg, Accounts Property Coordinator, reported that the State's Attorney was working on procedures for leasing Lot 1, East Side, Jamestown Reservoir.

The Board directed Ms. Eckelberg to send a reminder to cabin owners that mowing pathways from their lot through the Bureau's buffer was not permitted.

Ms. Eckelberg requested permission to submit grant applications to Garrison Diversion to assist with the Marina bathroom accessibility update. Kaiser made a motion that was seconded by Neys to authorize the grant applications. Motion carried.

Ms. Eckelberg reviewed the 2009 County Park budget. The cost of paving the Marina parking lot would be added to the budget. Neys made a motion that was seconded by Schlecht to submit the Park's 2009 budget to the Stutsman County Commission. Motion carried.

Ova made a motion that was seconded by Woodward to authorize \$1,274.10 for repairing the road damage at Pelican Point caused by upgrading the campground. Roll call vote – Woodward, Ova, Marks, Kaiser, Neys, Klose and Schlecht voted aye.

Commissioner Klose voiced concerns over the weed problems on the Bureau land. Larry Kuntz, Bureau of Reclamation, reported that the Bureau is aware of the problem and is working on it.

A motion to adjourn the Park Board meeting was made by Schlecht and seconded by Woodward. At 5:28 p.m. the August 5, 2008 County Park Board meeting was adjourned.

At 5:29 p.m. the Stutsman County Commission meeting was called back to order with all members present.

Ova made a motion that was seconded by Marks to pay the monthly bills. Roll call vote – Neys, Klose, Ova, Marks and Kaiser voted aye.
