

Official Proceedings of the Stutsman County Commission

August 18, 2009

At 8:00 a.m., Vice -Chairman Ova called the regular meeting of the Stutsman County Commission to order. Dennis Ova, Dale Marks, Craig Neys and Doug Kaiser answered roll call. Mark Klose was absent.

Connie Ova, CEO-JSDC, requested approval of a \$75,000 Flex PACE interest buy down for Dean Hafner d/b/a Allen Enterprises, Inc. for a new building that will be leased by Kevin Thoele d/b/a Buffalo City Diesel. The benefits of the interest buy down would be passed to Mr. Thoele in the form of reduced lease payments. Kaiser made a motion seconded by Neys to approve the funding on an 80/20 City/County split or \$15,000 in County funds. Roll call vote – Ova, Marks, Kaiser and Neys voted aye.

Ms. Ova presented a Tier 1 funding request by the North Dakota Trade Office for \$25,000 on an 80/20 City/County split. Mark Johnson, ND Trade Office, indicated that the funds would be used in an effort to enhance exports for six local businesses. The Office has had good success with out-trade missions and with bringing foreign buyers into the area to purchase from local businesses. Marks made a motion seconded by Kaiser to approve \$5,000 in County funds. Roll call vote – Marks, Kaiser, Neys and Ova voted aye.

Ms. Ova updated the Commission on the progress of Great River Energy. GRE had applied for a \$35.212 million Department of Energy grant. JSDC could receive \$8.5 million from this grant to be specifically used for the Spiritwood Energy Project – possible connecting road upgrade, rail service, etc.

Noel Johnson, County COO, presented a resolution that would create all of Stutsman County as a Recovery Zone for the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. Stutsman County had been allocated \$6.7 million for Economic Development Bonds and \$10.0 million for Facility Bonds. The development bonds could be used by private business for low cost financing. The facility bonds could be used by local governments – cities and the county – for low cost financing for infrastructure projects. A motion was made by Kaiser seconded by Marks to approve the resolution. Motion carried.

Jerry Bergquist, 9-1-1 Coordinator/Emergency Manager, requested acceptance of a \$36,000 federal grant that would be used to rewrite the County's disaster mitigation plan. The grant required \$12,000 of in-kind match. The money would be used to hire Nick of Time to rewrite the plan. Kaiser made a motion seconded by Neys to accept the grant award. Motion carried.

Johnson reported on a damaged window at the Senior Citizen's Center in Streeter. The building was owned by the County and leased by the Senior Citizens. A motion was made by Kaiser seconded by Neys to pay up to \$1,000 for the repairs. Roll call vote – Kaiser, Neys, Ova and Marks voted aye.

Neys made a motion seconded by Kaiser to approve the site authorization for the National Buffalo Museum at the Jamestown Country Club. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Neys and seconded by Marks to increase the mileage reimbursement rate from \$0.45 to \$0.55 per mile similar to the increase by the State. Roll call vote – Neys, Ova, Marks and Kaiser voted aye.

Marks made a motion seconded by Kaiser to pay \$150.00 in taxable meals. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Marks seconded by Kaiser to pay the mid-month bills. Roll call vote – Ova, Marks, Kaiser and Neys voted aye.
