

Official Proceedings of the Stutsman County Commission

September 15, 2009

At 8:00 a.m., Chairman Klose called the regular meeting of the Stutsman County Commission to order. Dennis Ova, Dale Marks, Craig Neys, Doug Kaiser and Mark T. Klose answered roll call. Also present was Logan County Commissioner Jack Erbele. Logan County Commissioner Dean Entzminger and Logan County Auditor Blanche Schumacher were present by speaker phone.

At 8:01 a.m. the meeting was recessed for a joint meeting with Logan County for the hearing on the 2010 Central Valley Health District budget.

Klose asked for nominations to chair the meeting. Ova made a motion seconded by Neys for Klose to chair the meeting. Motion carried.

Robin Iszler, Central Valley Health District Administrator, reviewed the budget. Stutsman County's share of the budget was \$684,786. Logan County's share was \$55,983. Neys made a motion seconded by Erbele to approve the 2010 health district budget. Roll call vote – Entzminger, Erbele, Ova, Marks, Kaiser, Neys and Klose voted aye.

Iszler indicated that the Health District partnered with the Barnes County Health Department, would receive a grant of \$300,000 for 3 years to work on case management of chronic diseases. This amount is over and above the 2010 budget.

Commissioner Ova made a motion to adjourn the joint commission meeting seconded by Commissioner Kaiser. Motion carried. At 8:05 a.m. the joint meeting was adjourned.

At 8:06 a.m. the regular County Commission meeting was called back to order with all Commissioners present.

Commissioner Klose suggested some type of compensation for all the extra hours and extra efforts made during the recent flood. Ova made a motion seconded by Marks to pay Jerry Bergquist \$3,500 and to pay Mike Zimmerman and Noel Johnson \$2,000. Johnson thanked the commission, but he indicated that he would not take any extra compensation. Roll call vote – Ova, Marks, Kaiser, Neys and Klose voted aye.

Johnson presented the final projected ending fund balances that reflected the numbers from the approved 2010 revenue and expenditure budgets.

Joan Halvorson, Victim Witness Advocate, requested permission to attend the National Conference on Responding to Crime Victims with Disabilities in Denver, Colorado from September 29 through October 2, 2009. Most of the cost of the trip would be paid from a \$1,000 scholarship that she had received. A motion was made by Kaiser seconded by Ova to approve the out-of-state travel. Roll call vote – Marks, Kaiser, Neys, Klose and Ova voted aye.

Fritz Fremgen, State's Attorney, requested panic buttons or some type of security for his office. Various threats had been received and his employees would like some type of system to avert potential incidents. The Commission requested ideas, options and costs for a security system.

Mike Zimmerman, County Highway Superintendent, indicated that 12 Emergency Relief (ER) projects had been approved by ND DOT. Steve Thompson, Interstate Engineering, presented 12 engineering

contracts for the projects. Ova made a motion seconded by Kaiser to approve the contracts and to submit plans for the ER projects. Roll call vote – Kaiser, Neys, Klose, Ova and Marks voted aye.

Zimmerman requested permission to solicit bids for a machine to recycle pavement. Estimated costs were about \$388,000. Kaiser made a motion seconded by Neys to solicit bids for a pavement recycling machine. Motion carried.

Jim Fettig, Courthouse Maintenance Supervisor, reviewed cost estimates from roofing contractors to update a portion of the Courthouse roof. Twin City Roofing had submitted the low proposal. Kaiser made a motion seconded by Marks to hire Twin City Roofing at a proposed cost of \$23,091. Roll call vote – Neys, Klose, Ova, Marks and Kaiser voted aye.

A motion was made by Ova seconded by Marks to approve \$190.00 in taxable meals. Roll call vote – Klose, Ova, Marks, Kaiser and Neys voted aye.

Kaiser made a motion seconded by Neys to pay the mid-month bills. Roll call vote – Ova, Marks, Kaiser, Neys and Klose voted aye.
