Official Proceedings of the Stutsman County Commission – September 17, 2019

At 4:35 p.m., Chairman Klose called the regular meeting of the Stutsman County Commission to order. Denny Ova, Ramone Gumke, Dave Schwartz, Steven Cichos, and Mark Klose answered the roll call.

Corry Shevlin, JSDC, presented a City of Jamestown funding request for a new National Guard facility. The City of Jamestown would pay for the lease, but the lease will be in the North Dakota National Guard name. A motion to approve the request was made by Schwartz, seconded by Gumke. Roll call: Schwartz, Cichos, Klose, Ova and Gumke voted aye. Motion carried.

A motion to approve an out of state travel request was made by Ova, seconded by Gumke. Motion carried.

The October 15th Commission Meeting date was moved to October 22, 2019.

A PILT (Payment in Lieu of Tax) for the Eagle Flats LLC was presented by Nicole Meland, Auditor/COO.

A request to go through Sanford for drug testing was made by Meland. Monthly, the DOT (Department of Transportation) requires drivers for the Stutsman County Road Department to be randomly selected for drug tests. Sanford would be drawing the names. Shannon Larson, Stutsman County Human Resource Specialist, would receive the list and pick a date. This would be implemented in January. Schwartz made a motion to switch to Sanford for drug testing, seconded by Ova. Motion carried.

Jim Stewart, Arntson Stewart Wegner PC, requested approval for a Resolution to bonds for Eventide Senior Living. The bonds would be used for a 43 unit assisted living facility. Cichos made a motion to approve the presented request, seconded by Ova. Roll call: Cichos, Klose, Ova, Gumke and Schwartz voted aye. Motion carried.
