

Official Proceedings of the Stutsman County Commission

September 20, 2011

At 7:00 a.m., Chairman Klose called the mid month meeting of the Stutsman County Commission to order. Dennis Ova, David Schwartz, Craig Neys and Mark T. Klose answered roll call. Dale Marks was absent.

Chad Kaiser, County Sheriff, reviewed the vehicle bids as follows: Don Wilhelm Inc – 2012 GMC Sierra ½ ton crew cab SLE, \$10,194 with trade and \$29,194 with no trade; R. M. Stoudt – 2012 Ford F150, \$12,939 with trade and \$29,560 with no trade. Quotes for a replacement car were reviewed as follows: R.M. Stoudt – new 2011 Ford Taurus, \$12,945 with trade; and Don Wilhelm Inc – new 2011 Chevy Impala LS, \$9,772 with trade. Ova made a motion seconded by Schwartz to accept the low bid of \$10,194 from Wilhelms for the pickup and approve the purchase of the car for \$9,772 from Wilhelms. Roll call vote – Ova, Schwartz, Neys and Klose voted aye.

A motion was made by Ova seconded by Schwartz to appoint Commissioner Neys as the County’s delegate to the State Fair Association’s annual meeting. Motion carried.

Ova made a motion seconded by Neys to appoint Commissioner Schwartz as the County’s delegate to the annual NDACo conference. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Schwartz seconded by Neys to pay \$141.50 in taxable meals and to pay the mid-month bills. Roll call vote – Schwarz, Neys, Klose and Ova voted aye.

Noel Johnson, Auditor/COO, reviewed the revenue and expenditure budgets, projected mill levies and projected ending fund balances. The expenditure budgets included a 2% COLA (Cost of Living Adjustment) and a step (2%) raise for the employees. The budgets included the 1% employer's and the 1% employees increase in PERS (Public Employees Retirement System) and a 3.5% increase in employee health insurance premiums. The revenue forecasts were based on a total mill levy of 114.71 mills up 0.2 mills from last year. Mills were increased for road repairs by 3.78 mills. Mills were decreased in other funds by 3.58 mills. Projected deficit spending was over \$3.3 million unless cuts were made from expenditure budgets submitted by the department heads.

Johnson indicated that other budget increases were for a new 9-1-1 system (\$265,000), \$2.0 million increase from 2011 for repairing roads under water (total cost of over \$3 million), and \$400,000 for building repairs.

Mickey Nenow, County Highway Superintendent, reviewed the Road Department budget. Expenditures were up from \$2.8 million to \$3.4 million. The Emergency Fund budget included \$2.6 million as the County's share of the projected \$13 million in permanent repairs for roads under water. Chip sealing the Ypsilanti and Montpelier roads, and purchasing two motor graders instead of one added \$585,000 to the budget.

Jim Fettig, Courthouse and Memorial Building Maintenance Supervisor, reviewed the Courthouse and Memorial Building budgets. The General Fund budget request included a request to increase a part time employee from 75% time to full time. The Courthouse Building Fund was increased from \$88,700 to \$410,300. A new roof on the Courthouse, ADA bathroom updates, a new front on the Memorial Building and other small projects were the reasons for the increase.

The Commission cut \$166,000 from the Courthouse and Memorial Building Fund. Transfers from the General Fund to the Courthouse Building Fund were increased from \$100,100 to \$134,000 to cover potential deficits. Medina's Rescue Squad's request for an increase of \$1,950 was reduced to an increase of \$1,000. The States Attorney's \$2,000 contingent fee was cut. Two additional part time dispatchers were left in the budget. No new dispatchers would be hired unless approved by the Commission. The total deficit spending was reduced to \$2.9 million.

A motion was made by Ova seconded by Neys to approve the budgets as amended and to authorize a total mill levy of not more than 115 mills. The mill rate could fluctuate depending on yet to be certified utility valuations. Roll call vote – Neys, Klose, Ova and Marks voted aye.

Schwartz made a motion seconded by Neys to adjourn. At 10:20 a.m., the mid month meeting of the Stutsman County Commission was adjourned.
