

Official Proceedings of the Stutsman County Commission

October 5, 2010

At 4:00 p.m., Chairman Klose called the special joint meeting of the Stutsman County Commission and the Logan County Commission to order. Dennis Ova, Dale Marks, Craig Neys, and Mark T. Klose answered roll call for Stutsman County. John Wald and Jack Erbele answered roll call for Logan County. The purpose of the joint meeting was to approve the Central Valley Health District's 2011 budget.

Ova made a motion to nominate Mark Klose as chairman of the joint meeting. Wald made a motion seconded by Neys to cease nominations and cast a unanimous ballot for Klose. Motion carried.

Robin Iszler, Central Valley Health District Administrator, reviewed the budget. The Logan County share of the budget was \$59,426 and the Stutsman County share was \$770,682. Neys made a motion seconded by Erbele to approve the budget. Roll call vote – Wald, Erbele, Ova, Marks, Neys and Klose voted aye.

Ova made a motion seconded by Marks to adjourn the joint meeting. At 4:05 p.m. the meeting was adjourned.

At 4:06 p.m. Chairman Klose called the regular monthly meeting of the Stutsman County Commission to order with all commissioners present.

Ova made a motion seconded by Marks to approve the minutes of the September meetings. Motion carried.

The hearing was held to consider the application of Allied Agronomy for \$2.5 million in recovery zone facility revenue bonds. John Arntson, Bond Attorney, indicated that they planned to build a 30,000 square foot distribution warehouse. The tax free bonds were authorized under the Municipal Industrial Development Act (MIDA). There was no risk or obligation for the County. Neys made a motion seconded by Ova to approve the bonds. Roll call vote – Ova, Marks, Neys and Klose voted aye.

A motion was made by Ova seconded by Marks to appoint Commissioner Neys as the County's ND State Fair delegate. Motion carried.

At the request of County COO (Auditor) Johnson, the first meeting of the Commission for November would be moved from November 2nd to November 9th due to the General Election.

Chairman Klose opened the 2011 budget hearing. Noel Johnson, County COO, reviewed the revenue and expenditure budgets, projected 2011 ending fund balances and the projected 2010 County mill levies. A motion was made by Ova seconded by Marks to approve \$19,492,200 in expenditures, \$17,907,675 in revenues, projected 2011 ending fund balance of \$7,630,262 and a 2010 mill levy of 113.67 mills. Roll call vote – Marks, Neys, Klose and Ova voted aye.

Fritz Fremgen, State's Attorney, gave his monthly report.

Todd Volk, Assistant Emergency Manager, presented the resolution to adopt the County's Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan. The resolution finalized the rewrite of the plan as a part of Stutsman County's long term preparedness and recovery strategies which promoted the development and implementation of both pre and post disaster mitigation measures. Ova made a motion seconded by Neys to approve the resolution. Roll call vote – Neys, Klose, Ova and Marks voted aye.

A motion was made by Neys seconded by Ova to approve the site authorization of Arrowwood Ducks Unlimited at the 281 Stop in Pingree. Motion carried.

Johnson presented a list of 19 individuals that had submitted applications to fill the unexpired term of Doug Kaiser on the County Commission. The Commission each voted for three individuals to interview to try and narrow the list down to five individuals. The vote tally indicated that six individuals had received votes. The following six individuals - Steven J Cichos, Clarence Daniel, Mark Dockter, Calvin Dupree, Bob Lulay and David Schwartz would be interviewed at a special commission meeting on October 7, 2010, beginning at 4:00 p.m.

At 4:45 p.m. the commission meeting was recessed.
