Official Proceedings of the Stutsman County Commission

October 7, 2008

At 4:00 p.m., Chairman Klose called to order the regular monthly meeting of the Stutsman County Commission. Commissioners Dennis Ova, Dale Marks, Doug Kaiser, Craig Neys and Mark T. Klose were present.

A motion to approve the minutes of the September, 2008 meetings was made by Neys and seconded by Kaiser. Motion carried.

Drew Wrigley, US Attorney, and Chris Myers, Assistant US Attorney, thanked the Drug Task Force, the local law enforcement agencies and the Stutsman County State's Attorney's Office for their assistance with the apprehension and prosecution of a drug ring under the "Operation White Cloud". Sergeant Troy Kelly from the task force was presented a plaque from the US Department of Justice for his work on this case and other cases that have resulted in 1151 months of incarceration without parole.

Raymond Johnson requested closing the section line between the SE1/4 of Section 34 and the SW1/4 of Section 35-T140N-R65W, in Eldridge Township. He used the road as an airplane runway. The railroad crossing to the north had been removed and the road was a dead end as it was intersected by I-94. Letters to the Commission opposing the closing had been received from the Eldridge Township Board and adjacent land owners, Earl, Ann and Troy Letcher. Bob Moser, Manager of Main Line Agronomy, also spoke in opposition to the closing. Marks made a motion that was seconded by Neys to deny the request. Roll call vote – Ova, Marks, Kaiser, Neys and Klose voted aye.

The hearing on the proposed 2009 expenditure and revenue budgets was opened. Noel Johnson, County COO, reviewed the budgets. The budget forecast was \$16.67 million in expenditures and \$15.73 million in revenues. The 2008 mill levy projection of 108.6 mills was down from 108.96 mills in 2007. The mill levy would generate \$6.07 million in property taxes. Ova made a motion that was seconded by Kaiser to approve the 2009 budgets and the projected 2008 mill levies. Roll call vote – Marks, Kaiser, Neys, Klose and Ova voted aye.

Jan Thompson, County Treasurer, reviewed the status of County reserve funds in light of the current financial turmoil in the US economy. The County's \$8.4 million in reserve funds were protected by \$14.9 million in pledged securities. The securities were direct debt obligations guaranteed by the US Government.

Andrew Schneider, Jamestown Regional Airport Manager, requested matching funds for a new 18' snow plow. The \$18,000 cost would be offset by a 50/50 match from State Aeronautics Commission. He was requesting \$4,500 of the required matching funds from the County. Commissioner Klose expressed his concerns with funding projects over and above the mill levy that was approved for the airport. No action was taken.

Fritz Fremgen, State's Attorney, reviewed his monthly report.

At 5:03 p.m., the meeting was recessed for the Park Board meeting.

At 5:08 p.m., Chairman Klose called to order the Stutsman County Park Board meeting. Board members Bob Woodward, Dennis Ova, Dale Marks, Doug Kaiser, Craig Neys and Mark T. Klose were present. Mark Schlecht was absent.

A motion to approve the September, 2008 minutes was made by Woodward and seconded by Ova. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Ova and seconded by Woodward to pay the monthly bills. Roll call vote – Woodward, Ova, Marks, Kaiser, Neys and Klose voted ave.

The winner would be notified and required to submit the appropriate fees.

Dennis Lorenz, County Park Superintendent, gave his monthly report. Pelican Point Landing Update: the RV pads had been widened; Border States Paving had completed the road repairs - the work was marginally satisfactory; the boat landing concrete was breaking up - the broken concrete could not be removed without damaging the Park Board's equipment; the well water had been treated to solve the odor problems - but beyond that, nothing could be done. All the disability access issues on the Bureau property were up to date to meet the 2010 deadline.

At 5:35 p.m., a motion to adjourn the Park Board meeting was made by Woodward and seconded by Neys. Motion carried.

At 5:36 p.m. the regular Commission meeting was called back to order with all Commissioners present.

Marks made a motion that was seconded by Kaiser to allow the road department to purchase a laser level. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Neys and seconded by Kaiser to approve the Memorandum of Understanding between the State of North Dakota and Stutsman County for the purchase and maintenance of electronic poll books. Motion carried.

A motion to approve the monthly bills was made by Marks and seconded by Kaiser. Roll call vote – Kaiser, Neys, Klose, Ova and Marks voted aye.
