

Official Proceedings of the Stutsman County Commission – November 3rd, 2015

At 4:00 p.m., Chairman Klose called the regular meeting of the Stutsman County Commission to order. Mark T. Klose, Dennis Ova, Dale Marks, Craig Neys, and David Schwartz answered the roll call.

Neys made a motion, seconded by Marks to approve the minutes of the October 2015 meetings. Motion Carried.

Nellie Degen, Fraternal Order of Police Liaison, presented an update on Fraternal Order of Police regarding the Law Enforcement PERS (Public Employees Retirement System).

Easter Seals requested a public hearing on Easter Seals MIDA Bonds request. With this bond there is no obligation to the County. A representative from Easter Seals spoke about the project. There were no comments heard. Schwartz made a motion, seconded by Ova to approve the Pledge Agreement, Loan Service Agreement and resolution as presented. Roll call vote: Ova, Marks, Schwartz, Neys and Klose voted aye. Motion carried.

Jim Fettig, Maintenance Supervisor, informed the commissioners on a bid approval for a courthouse facility grant for the juvenile court basement remodel. Estimated cost to begin the project is \$44,653.06. Schumacher Construction Inc. was awarded the lowest bid at \$19,860.00. The low bid overall total is \$36,619.59. Ova made a motion to award the bid to Schumacher Construction, seconded by Marks. Roll call vote: Marks, Schwartz, Neys, Klose and Ova voted aye. Motion carried.

Mickey Nenow, County Highway Superintendent presented his monthly report. Final inspections took place last week including the cement stabilization on the GRE Spiritwood location and 7 miles North of Gackle highway 67. Chip seal will be postponed until next year. Finalizations will continue to take place with the road North of Woodworth. Concerns were brought up regarding potholes East of Montpelier.

Fritz Fremgen, State's Attorney, presented his monthly report. Secure disposal of at least 10 years of files/records will be completed by the Records Keepers.

Casey Bradley, Auditor/COO, presented a Social Media Policy to add to the Personnel Policy. Bradley informed the commissioners of the potential uses of utilizing more media with each department to keep the community well informed. Advantages and disadvantages were discussed. Schwartz made a motion, seconded by Marks to approve the Social Media Policy and add it to the Personnel Policy as presented. Motion carried.

Commissioner Schwartz presented additional Holiday Closings. The 27<sup>th</sup> of November, 2015 (The day after Thanksgiving) and the half day of the 24<sup>th</sup> of December, 2015 were requested off. Schwartz made a motion, seconded by Marks to approve the request as presented. Motion carried.
