

Official Proceedings of the Stutsman County Commission

November 6, 2008

At 3:00 p.m., Chairman Klose called to order the regular monthly meeting of the Stutsman County Commission. Commissioners Dennis Ova, Dale Marks, Doug Kaiser, Craig Neys and Mark T. Klose were present.

A motion to approve the minutes of the October 2008 meetings was made by Neys and seconded by Kaiser. Motion carried.

No one appeared at the hearing on the minimum sale prices for the 2008 tax foreclosure properties. Ova made a motion that was seconded by Kaiser to accept the minimum sale prices for the properties subject to the November 18, 2008 tax sale as presented. Motion carried.

Neys made a motion that was seconded by Marks to appoint Commissioner Ova to the General Election Canvass Board to serve in the place of the Commission Chairman who could not serve as he was a candidate in the election. Motion carried.

Mike Zimmerman, County Highway Superintendent, informed the Board that there may be up to \$200,000 in road funds available from the ND Department of Transportation. Plans for any projects would have to be submitted within 90 days. Efforts continued to determine the County's road right-of-way before a plan could be finalized to deal with the encroachment issues along the roads. A landowner had contacted Zimmerman to remove the County's stock pile of gravel on their land. The County had a written agreement allowing the storage on the land until it was used. The matter was referred to the State's Attorney.

Fritz Fremgen, State's Attorney, gave his monthly report. Because the joint library issue had passed, an agreement would have to be drafted between the City and County.

Tracey Trapp, LEC Administrator, requested out-of-state travel for Wendy Thompson to attend health care training in St Cloud and for Trapp to attend the Bureau of Prisons conference in Minneapolis. Kaiser made a motion that was seconded by Neys to allow the out-of-state travel. Motion carried.

At 3:28 p.m., the meeting was recessed for the Park Board meeting.

At 3:37 p.m., Board member Mark Schlecht was in attendance.

Sandra Eckelberg, Accounts Property Coordinator, reported that all cabin owners at the Reservoir were in compliance with their septic systems.

Noel Johnson, County COO, discussed the Bureau of Reclamation's requirement that the fees for seasonal and year-around leases needed to be increased to the Bureau's standard by 2011. An index was applied to the lease fees. The index indicated that the lease rates for 2008 should be increased from \$500 to \$783 for seasonal leases and from \$1,200 to \$1,880 for year-around leases. The Park Board could increment the increase over a three-year period.

James Nygaard, representing the Cabin Owners Association, questioned where the numbers for the index came from. Nellie and Bill Degen also voiced concerns over the basis and foundation of the index. At the December Board meeting, representatives of the Bureau of Reclamation would be asked to attend and present information on the lease fees and the basis of the land index.

Kevin Arthaud requested permission to conduct another "Polar Plunge" at the Reservoir on February 14, 2009 or March 7, 2009 if the weather does not permit the earlier date. The event had 64 participants that raised \$20,000 last year for Special Olympics North Dakota. Neys made a motion that was seconded by Kaiser to grant permission for the event. Motion carried.

Dennis Lorenz, County Park Superintendent, gave his monthly report. The fireplace at the Parkhurst shelter had been removed and other renovations had been completed. The tree spade truck had been repaired and good progress had been made on moving trees. Many loads of silt had been removed at the Marina boat ramp. A new group shelter across the bay from the Marina had been completed. The crew was removing dead trees from County Park locations. A \$12,500 Garrison Diversion grant had been awarded to the Park Board for the Lakeside Marina Campground bathhouse renovation.

At 4:20 p.m., a motion to adjourn the Park Board meeting was made by Woodward and seconded by Schlecht. Motion carried.

At 4:21 p.m. the regular Commission meeting was called back to order with all Commissioners present.

A motion to approve the monthly bills was made by Marks and seconded by Neys. Roll call vote—Ova, Marks, Kaiser, Neys, and Klose voted aye.
