A motion to appoint Deb Lee to the Social Service Board was made by Kaiser, seconded by Marks. Motion carried.

Jay Schmitz, Chief Assistant State's Attorney gave their monthly report.

At 4:28 p.m. the Commission meeting was recessed for the County Park Board meeting.
