

Official Proceedings of the Stutsman County Commission – December 19, 2017

At 4:35 p.m., Chairman Klose called the regular meeting of the Stutsman County Commission to order. Dale Marks, David Schwartz, Denny Ova, Mark T. Klose, and Craig Neys answered the roll call.

Denny Ova, County Commissioner, requested closure of Stutsman County on December 26, 2017. Schwartz made a motion to accept the request, seconded by Marks. Motion carried.

Mickey Nenow, Road Superintendent, presented his monthly report. Winter service on equipment is being started in the shop. Road Department is still doing some rocking, weather permitted. Interstate Engineering is working on the preliminary engineering for the 3 mile road project next year by the State Hospital and Butler.

Nenow has money left over in the budget for purchase of the assets and is requesting to purchase a plasma cutter for the shop. One quote in town was for \$2,804.00. If something breaks it would be more convenient to go into town and get the part(s) needed. Ova made a motion, seconded by Schwartz to approve the request to purchase a plasma cutter. Roll call vote: Marks, Schwartz, Neys, Klose, and Ova voted aye. Motion carried.

David Schwartz, County Commissioner, indicated there is some additional federal aid road funding available in 2019. Schwartz had Mike May, Interstate Engineering, complete some calculations on County Road 39 (Scherbenske Road). Stutsman County would be borrowing ahead on their federal aid dollars and would like to be borrowed ahead the maximum by 2020. Funds can be borrowed ahead up to 3 years. The County would have to budget for the match. County Roads 67 or 68 North may need overlays.

Corry Shevlin, JSDC, requested additional Flex PACE Interest Buy-downs. JSDC was in once this year to set up the program and a second time to start the program. JSDC is requesting up to \$345,000.00 on an 80/20 split between city and county. The county share would be \$69,000.00, which will cover the maximum amount of the remaining projects left. Shevlin doesn't believe the requests are going to be that high, but is requesting the maximum so they don't have to come back and request more money or hold the projects up. Marks made a motion to approve the request, seconded by Schwartz. Roll call vote: Schwartz, Neys, Klose, Ova, and Marks voted aye. Motion carried.

Nicole Meland, Interim Auditor/COO requested approval of beer and liquor licenses for the Hitching Post, Stutsman County Fair Association, Sportsmans Bar and a beer license for Speedway Concessions, Inc. Schwartz made a motion, seconded by Ova to approve the beer and liquor licenses as presented. Motion carried.

Meland requested approval of cabin permit renewals for lots 41W, 6W, 65W, 58W, 33W and 37W. Schwartz made a motion to approve the presented cabin permit renewals, seconded by Marks. Motion carried.

Mark Klose, Commission Chairman, was contacted by the University of Jamestown requesting a letter of support for USDA funding. There are no financial commitments on the County's behalf. Ova made a motion to send the University of Jamestown a letter of support, seconded by Schwartz. Motion carried.

Ova made a motion, seconded by Marks to approve paying the taxable meals and mid-month bills. Roll call vote: Neys, Klose, Ova, Marks, and Schwartz voted aye. Motion carried.
