

Official Proceedings of the Stutsman County Commission – May 14, 2015

At 8:00 a.m., Chairman Klose called the special meeting of the Stutsman County Commission to order. Dennis Ova, David Schwartz, Craig Neys, and Mark T. Klose answered the roll call. Dale Marks is absent.

Mickey Nenow, County Road Superintendent is requesting to go out for advertising for bids to repair, pave, & chip seal the one mile on County Highway 44 north of Woodworth. Auditor Bradley spoke with Brian Fuchs, North Dakota Department of Transportation, regarding the funding of the project and if the project has been approved. Fuchs stated the project is approved and in his opinion changing the scope of the project would not affect the end product. The plans have been approved and the project is authorized. Ova made a motion, seconded by Schwartz to approve the advertising request as presented. Motion Carried.

Nenow is requesting to patch and chip seal County Highways 67 and 69 and the remainder of County Highway 44 as bid alternates. Mickey has 20 miles of chip sealing in the budget this year. Schwartz made a motion, seconded by Neys to approve the request as presented. Motion Carried.
